## Track and Overhead Refurbishment Australian Electric Transport Museum (S.A.)

Over the last three years we have focussed on significant upgrading of our track and overhead.

The AETM approached the City of Salisbury, owners of the majority of our tram line for the road crossings to be significantly upgraded.

The Council agreed and significant works were carried out by Council and contractors in the first half of 2020

Work – near Mangrove St was managed by AETM Track and Overhead team in conjunction with our contractor NED (North East Demolition).



# Funding the reconstruction of Wendouree Parade track

## Ballarat Tramway Museum

- State Government ran a community grant program, called “Pick My Project” the local community would vote for projects.
- Used Social Media Channels - Facebook, Instagram, Twitter and eNews digital newsletter to promote the project.
- City of Ballarat confirmed the \$250,000 for the project. This would not have been forthcoming unless we had gained the votes from the Community itself.



## Renovation of Restaurant Tram 411

- Saloons fitted up with new frame work and reclad.
- Cabs repaired and rebuilt.
- Saloon floors replaced new plywood.
- New crown plates installed.
- New cab platform extensions installed
- Air brake piping replaced with new flexible plastic plumbing.
