Talking Tram app

New tram app for smart devices revolutionises Talking Tram tour.

To the best of our knowledge, this is the first time that beacon technology has been used to deliver a tour on a moving vehicle anywhere in the world.

The app offers diverse commentaries in different languages, shares historical imagery and also provides maps and information about what to do at each tram stop.
